Quick Start Instructions

Technique

- As the Airbrush® Liposculptor does all the work, manual reciprocation is not needed. The optimal technique is that of "continuous, even, slow motion" and feathering. Avoid "hovering" in one spot and don't let the outer cannula slot emerge from the incision while the inner cannula is reciprocating.
- Set full stroke first and then gradually decrease to desired length and power for maximal smoothness and silence of operation.



- Locate the slot superficial to the area of fatty excess and allow the *Airbrush® Liposculptor* to effortlessly remove fat in a precise and controlled fashion until the desired effect is obtained.
- For enhanced results you may briefly direct the slot superficially to encourage skin retraction.

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- Since the concern is only the proper placement of the instrument, judgment of how much fat to remove from each location, and an even feathering of the borders, the surgeon is free to be an artist without the drudgery of manual cannula reciprocation.
- The surgeon can pinch the pannus about the cannula and literally feed fat globules into the slot for aspiration of any residual unevenness or lumps under precise control.



In addition to selecting an appropriate sized cannulas set, to increase the control of fat removal the surgeon may adjust the stroke or rate (*Airbrush ® Liposculptor I* only) of reciprocation using the knob(s) on the hand piece. Turn stroke fully off and then fully on to reset.

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- Though most surgeons will prefer the default amount of stroke awareness we set at the factory, the cushion may be adjusted to the surgeon's preference by the manufacturer's representative to be more or less gentle.
- The reciprocation of the inner cannula is visible through the transparent chamber cover.



• To eliminate drag, decrease vibration, and increase the speed of reciprocation you may temporarily fasten the vacuum tubing, with about 3" of slack, to the multicore cable using a sterile cable tie approximately 2' behind the hand piece if desired.

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
